UMM Home Repair Program

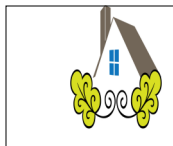


The UMM continue to provide home repair service to assist DSUMC members to repair minor home problems.

Electronic giving part II

Now that several families have signed on to use our direct deposit plan to make their contributions to the church, I have discovered another method that may be preferable to direct deposit. If you use bill pay on your computer to pay bills from home, you should be able to make your contributions by making Desert Skies one of your payees. Instead of electronically depositing the funds in the church account, your bank or credit union will mail a check to the church. The real advantage is that your name appears on the check, so we can promptly credit your donation. It turns out that with electronic direct deposit (contrary to what we were told by our credit union) there is no information on our statement to distinguish one donor from another except for their financial institution and the amount given. The more direct depositors we have, the harder it is to credit the donations in a timely manner.

If you would like to change from direct deposit to bill pay, let me know and I will cancel your direct deposit order. Sorry for the inconvenience. Isn't technology wonderful?

Hello Desert Skies!

Christ has risen, Spring has sprung, and schools everywhere are winding up before winding down. May is definitely a time of transition and new adventures, both in the life of our church and the life of the community around us. Let me take a moment to highlight a few of the transitions that are on my mind as I write this article today.

First off, we are winding down my first school year here at Desert Skies. We have had some victories and learned some lessons along the way, but overall I am excited to have gotten to know our youth a little better and to teach them a bit about me. Now we prepare to say goodbye to our graduating seniors and hello to a new class of Middle Schoolers, and I need your help with both. If you know a senior who is graduating from High School in May please send me her/his name by Sunday, May 15th. We will be honoring those graduates the following Sunday, May 22nd and we want to try our best not to miss anyone! If you know anyone starting 6th grade in the Fall please send me his/her name and contact information as soon as possible so we can welcome them and begin transitioning them into our youth group community over the Summer. In either case, please help us to ease the transitions of all our youth by welcoming them, congratulating them, and reminding them that wherever they are on their life's journey, they are never alone.

Second, while Summer often feels like a time of winding down for our faith community, our youth program is winding up for some big adventures! The Summer camping schedule is in my office and I am prepared to talk with children and youth about which camps might best fit their needs. In late June I will be traveling with three youth from our church and several others from churches around the country to Honduras to learn about how we can be good global neighbors to our sisters and brothers to the south, and in mid July I'll be taking more than 10 of our own youth to Youth 2011, a denomination-wide gathering of youth at Purdue University in Lafayette, IN. If you're interested in supporting our youth on either of these trips please contact me so we can talk about how best to do that. Finally, our Middle Schoolers will be gearing up for a city wide mission project in June where they will learn about communities of need in our own neighborhoods, and how God might be calling us as a community of faith to respond to those needs. All of this as we prepare to design and implement a new year of youth group that will be on us before we know it. Suffice it to say it's going to be a busy Summer!

We all thank you for your support as we gear up for transitions and adventures in these coming months, and we can't wait to tell you all about them. I invite each and every one of you to share in our excitement and help ease our anxiety by taking the time to talk with one of our youth. You never know what grand adventures you may hear about!

Missions Moment

Our Covenant Missionaries, Terry & Muriel Henderson of "Give Ye them To Eat" in south-central Mexico, are grateful for our prayers and financial support during 2010. They highlight how important this has been to their vital "More Than A Bandage" health program. Since 1996 it has trained 169 women as community-based, primary health workers serving 10,000-13,000 people annually in rural areas. 83% completed Basic, Intermediate & Advanced Health courses to graduate as Volunteer Health Workers of the Methodist Church of Mexico, but all attendees help improve community health by sharing acquired knowledge and skills with their families and neighbors.

Did you know that volunteers from all walks of life prepare fresh soup, assemble 500-600 single lunch bags and 150-200 food bags for families every day of the week at Casa Maria Free Kitchen on E. 26th St.? Our Desert Skies Soup Kitchen Team, which includes expert dishwasher Pastor Brian, serves on the 2nd Thursday of each month. We carpool in the church van at 7:45 a.m. or meet at Casa Maria around 8:15 a.m. and return by 11:30 a.m. Join us in nourishing the poor and needy of our community. We then discussed a request from Doreen Hedger for help on the 29th and 30th of April in painting the Casa Maria Kitchen and a crew to clean up Houghton Road near our church. Although we were not able to get bosses for these projects we were able to get some volunteers.

We then were treated to a discussion of this years Sierra Service Project where 10 youth and leaders will be going to a suburb of Tegucigalpa, Honduras to work on housing for the poor. Three young ladies from our church Courtney, Kenza and Elise told us what they will be doing, to the best of their knowledge for the two weeks they will be in Honduras. We agreed to fund the young ladies \$300.00 toward the cost of their trip. They also told us that as individuals we could buy a share of their trip for \$50.00 and that they would write to us during the trip and describe their experience. Pastor Brian accompanied the young ladies and explained that any help we provide the people of Honduras individually will reduce the likelihood they will come to the United States as illegal aliens, thus helping to reduce our burgeoning illegal alien problem.

After the meeting, around 12:00 noon our final golf tournament of the season was held at Dorado Country Club. Our next tournament will be held in October as will our next UMM meeting.
